

Reading Assignment Opt-Out Form



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Instructional and supplemental materials are selected for their compatibility with the District’s educational program and their ability to help fulfill the District’s educational goals and objectives. Per district policy (revised July 11, 2013), individuals wishing to challenge or express concerns about instructional or supplemental materials may do so by filling out a *Challenge to Instructional Material* form available in the school’s office.

However, should a parent find a particular reading assignment offensive, the teacher may (at his/her discretion) allow the parent to simply request an alternate reading assignment as opposed to going through the full process of submitting the *Challenge to Instructional Material* form.

By using this form, the teacher agrees that an alternate reading assignment will be provided, and that no further action is required.
